



The Timothy Project Apprenticeship Covenant

Description

Covenant to participate in a Coaching Apprenticeship Program for consideration of future leadership at Oasis Christian Fellowship.

Overview

Apprenticeship is a relationally based system in which future leaders are served by a leader through engagement, equipping and unleashing for ministry.

Commitment

The apprentice will meet with the leader on a bi-weekly basis for personal and educational development. The apprentice will also meet with other leaders and apprentices for a bi-monthly leadership summit.

- Outside The Ministry Context
 - Personal Development
 - Ministry Development (Vision, Distinctives & Structures of Oasis; identification and development of ministry role; prayer and strategy sessions)
- Inside The Ministry Context
 - Leader will help guide and transition apprentice into ministry
 - Leader will debrief apprentice during bi-weekly meetings
- Apprentice Development Four-Stage Process ("I do, you do")
 - Stage 1: Recruitment (identification of prospective apprentice) - F.A.C.T.S. (Titus 1:7-9; 1st Timothy 3:6-10)
 - Stage 2: Instruction (one-on-one and on-site training)
 - Stage 3: Evaluation (pastoral)
 - Stage 4: Release (to assume responsibility of a ministry; to transition from Apprentice-Leader relationship to Leader-Coach relationship)

Adherence

The apprentice will complete the Full-Devotion Course.

- To espouse the Vision Statement of Oasis Church: "To be a church of fully-devoted followers of Jesus Christ"
- To embrace the Three C's of the Great Commission: Christ, Church, Commission
- To exemplify the Five S's of Full Devotion: Salvation, Sunday Morning, Small Group, Stewardship, Service
